PHOEBE COOK LECTURE SERIES Featuring LEWIS MILLER November 11th @ 11:00

By day, the floral designer Lewis Miller creates arrangements of originality and abundance for major events in New York, which gained him International recognition. At night, Lewis Miller ventures into the streets to create his startling floral displays, installed guerilla style on street corners, construction sites, traffic signs, and subway entrances.

Lewis began his impromptu public displays as a way to use leftover flowers and foliage that would otherwise go to waste from events. Miller calls these guerilla installations "Flower Flashes"! He puts them together for the total pleasure of the public to enjoy!



What initially began as an experiment to reinvigorate and reconnect people to the craft of flowers turned into a beautiful shared experience in a city of millions.
